**Book Reports:** Students will be completing book reports each quarter. A separate book report sheet is available with all of the information and due dates.

**Research Paper and Writing:** The 12<sup>th</sup> graders will be completing one major research paper this year. More information will be given about this project as the time gets closer. We will also be doing a significant amount of writing of paragraphs, essays, etc. during class as we prepare for college and life after high school!

**Website:** Major projects and assignments will be posted on the website as well as the information needed to complete the projects. Also, any class news will be posted there as well. Daily assignments will not be posted on the website. Please refer to your child's assignment book for that information.
